


## **About us**



### **Description:**

The city of Prague has the largest castle complex in the world. It consists of several palaces, churches, gardens and many other special buildings. Prague Castle has a rich history and you will get to know it during this tour. The tour includes entrance to the buildings that are open on the day of the tour. An entrance ticket is valid for 2 days as standard, so if your customers have not finished looking yet, the guide can give the entrance ticket to your customers so that your customers can return later in the day or the next day. When your customers leave the castle, the walk continues towards Petrin Hill, there your customers have the opportunity to admire the Prague replica of the Eiffel Tower and if your customers wish, they can also climb it or go up with the elevator and from from there they have a breathtaking view of Prague and Prague Castle. Then we also visit Kampa Island. This island is also called little Venice within Prague. We end the tour in the cozy Malá Strana which means little side in Czech.


Kiss & Ride Hlavni Nadrazi (Central station), Wilsonova 300, Prague. Hotel Pick up also possible throughout Prague.

## **Description:**

During this tour we visit the Czech town of Theresienstadt and dive into the turbulent history of the Czech Republic during the Second World War. We visit the former concentration camp, then we visit a museum in the village and we conclude the tour at the crematorium. In total, the tour takes between 6-7 hours, including the approximately 1-hour outward journey and the 1-hour return journey. With this tour it is possible to be picked up at any hotel or apartment where you are staying. I Love Praag is one of the few tour operators who, in addition to tours in English and German, also provide tours entirely in Dutch.

We then continue the tour towards the Jiřího z Poděbrad park and square where we view the special church from the outside and the guide gives a brief explanation about the Czech Republic and religion. We end the tour on the square Náměstí Míru where we see the basilica from the outside and the beautiful building of Divadlo na Vinohradech one of the most beautiful theaters in Prague. The guide also tells about the metro station Náměstí Míru, which is the deepest point of the European Union for a reason. During the tour we also visit the necessary gay spots and show each person where he will really feel at home.
